GUESTS: Mike Wayne gave a warm welcome to members of the Elmira ROTARY CLUB, their veterans and spouses, who shared with Kiwanis Veterans and Spouses a special observance for VETERANS DAY. Our special speaker was Bruce Boughton, a native of Elmira, who enlisted in the United States Army Reserves in 1991 at the tender age of 17. After special training, he was a member of the 969th Maintenance Company until July of 1999, reenlisted and became a Combat Engineer and Drill Instructor, deployed to Iraq in 2004' Fort Dix in 2007, Saudi Arabia in 2009 and Afghanistan in 2014. He presently serves as the interim Command Sergeant Major for the 479th Engineer Battalion near Fort Drum and the recipient of a variety of awards and decorations over his 26 years of military service. He is Manager for Chemung Canal's Schuyler County offices in Watkins Glen and Montour Falls, a Rotarian, and resides in Horseheads with his wife Sherri and children. He spoke on his career, gave a history of Veterans Day before Kiwanis honored the Veterans who were present, with piano accompaniment by Dick Schornstheimer.
