"What it means NOT to be poor" Originally developed in Paraguay with indicators, program looks at **1. Income and Employment 2. Health and Environment, 3. Housing and Infrastructure, 4. Education and Culture, 5. Organization and Participation, and 6. Motivation and Interiority**. An area around Horigans is pin-pointed, with leadership training, focused on **100 families** talking, listening, learning all in partnership with local institutions. Program is putting Elmira on a global map and empowering families with a plan.
