Today's program was the annual Ernie Davis Awards Banquet! Ron Allison started the program talking about Ernie Dais and the fact that today would have been Ernie's 84<sup>th</sup> Birthday! Charles DeTaeye, Athletic Director at Horseheads & Chair of the Ernie Davis Award Committee presented information on the 3 nominees. He said that only 1 point separated the winner from the runner up! All 3 nominees are worthy of the award. First nominee is Brycen Guinnip from Thomas Edison – Bryson has amazing work ethic, character, and an unwavering determination to succeed. He has a 92.7GPA plans to attend college, student business and marketing while continuing to play football! On the field he is a two-year started playing both the offense & defense. He ran 1405 yards had 17 TDS on over 250 rushing attempts. Second is Evan Garvin from Elmira High School - a leader & true role model with the ability to generate confidence in others. He volunteers at the annual youth sports camp, participated in Read for the Record where he read to elementary students. Evan is a multi-sport athlete playing both basketball & lacrosse. On the field he is a vital member of the 2023 Section IV AAA Sectional Champion, Elmira Express. He played 4 years on varsity playing both quarterback & linebacker. He threw for 584 yds and 9 TDS on 36 completions. He also ran for 416 yds and 7 TDS accumulating over 1000 yds on offense. Third nominee is Bradock Salisbury from Horseheads High School – he is a hard worker who carries a 93 GPA and is a 3-sport athlete participating in both indoor & outdoor track. He just set the school record in the 55M sprint. He volunteers in the community. On the field he has started for the varsity for the past 2 seasons playing both running back & free safety. He rushed fir 787 yards and 10 TDS on 77 carries. He has accumulated over 1000 yards for offense and averaged over 100 yds per game. He returned both a kickoff for a touchdown and a fumble recovery for a touchdown this season. He was a Section All Star the last 2 seasons.
