Phil Shippers from the Alzheimer's Association out of Rochester, He covers Chemung and Steuben Counties. He is a dementia care specialist.

NY State estimated that over 400,000 have some sort of Dementia, that will rise to 460,000 in the next 3 years. Dementia is the umbrella term, Alzheimer is 70% of that.

There is a blood test to determine if there is plaque on the brain, now there is medication to help offset that plaque Age is #1 risk factor, also Genetics, Gender and Race, as well as head injuries. He comes to Elmira a couple times a week. There is an online library filled with information, as well, as printed material and a 24/7 help line

There are two support groups in our area, In Elmira, on Saturday's, at the Steel library, as well as in Horseheads, on the third Wednesday of the month at the First Presbyterian Church. There are education classes, as well as annual caregiver conference that is held in the fall.

They provide consultations: meet with the caregivers, evaluate and connect them with the proper people in the community. here are many volunteer opportunities - from office work to doing presentations at health fair. September 21 is the walkathon in Watkins Glen
