Our program today was Katie Boland from Meals on Wheels! She congratulated us for all the projects we are doing in the community. She is a member of Elmira Rotary and she said we do a lot more than Rotary does! We do share the Community Kitchen event. Katie talked about the amount of meals that they provide which totaled over 110,000 last year! They not only provide meals to their 293 clients but also to about 115 residents at Bragg Towers, Newtown Towers, etc. They are also providing some take home meals to the people receiving treatment at the Faulk Cancer Center. Currently they are proving about 100 meals a month to the Faulk Cancer Center but are waiting to hear on a grant that will allow them to provide 100 meals per week! She said that she loves providing food to the community, so this is an ideal job for her! They provide all the meals with 10 employees and about 200 volunteers who help prep food, package food and/or deliver the food! Meals on Wheels is also looking for donations of dog and cat food that they give their clients who are pet owners! Katie mentioned that her 2 fundraisers are the Mardi Gras party they had on Tuesday night at the Green Derby and the upcoming Night at the Races which will be on Sat March 23 from 6-10pm. Katie also mentioned that Mark Wayne & Jack Gilroy who deliver meals saved a woman who fell on her front lawn in the freezing cold! Kudos to Mark & Jack!!
