# Program

Matt Guagliardo from the Chemung SPCA gave an overview of the services available at the SPCA. Every SPCA is independent. They offer dog & cat adoptions as well as vaccines, microchip, nail trimming etc. The recently renovated their clinic space and updated protocols for the vaccine clinics since Covid. The have a partnership with the Family Reading Partnerships- Bright Red Bookshelf and volunteers read books to the cats! Today they are expecting about 20 puppies from the shelter in Alabama through Best Friends Animal Society to be adopted locally. There is a movement to make the US a kill free. The Northeast has a strong spay & neuter policy.

Right now the SPCA has about 20-30 cats and about 29 dogs (including the puppies arriving today). The animals normally are at the SPCA from 14-19 days. They run free rabies clinics through the Chemung County Health Department and also have a Community Pet Pantry where people can come to get free pet food if they are in need. They are always looking for pet food, blankets & towels. They make toys out of paper towel rolls for the animals.
