GATE 1 – Fairview Ave- Admission is \$10 per vehicle which covers parking and entry for the individuals in the car. **This is the only drive in gate**

Gate 2 – Fairview Ave- Walk up Gate – Admission is \$5 per person or \$3 in purchased online. There will be a large sign with a QR code to scan which would give the lower price. Only vehicles through this gate are law enforcement or Ambulances.

Gate 3 – Fairview Ave - **is now a pedestrian exit gate only! No vehicle entry!**

Gate 3A – Agriculture gate – only admission is with permit should have a displayed parking permit

Gate 4 – Walk in Gate – Grand Central Ave – Admission \$5 per person or \$3 if purchased on line (same as gate 1) QR code will be available to scan for lower price

Gate 5 – Exhibitors/vendors/Horse Gate – admission by credential/pass only! NO GENERAL PUBLIC. Parking is \$5 per vehicle. Only cars through this gate other than horse people are Demolition Derby etc.
